Mapeley and Quantum Plus pick up “Best Use of Outsourcing by an SME” Accolade at the Third Annual NOA Awards

London, 6 November 2006: Mapeley and Quantum Plus have today announced that together they have won the National Outsourcing Association's award for “Best Use of Outsourcing by an SME” at the 2006 NOA awards ceremony.

The awards, which were announced at a glittering ceremony at London's Radisson Portman Hotel, were hosted by Anthony Hilton, the financial editor of the Evening Standard. Attracting over 500 professionals, the awards aim to reward organisations for success in outsourcing projects, as well as raising awareness for the importance of best practice. The awards acknowledge achievements in IT and Business Process outsourcing, as well as sector specific achievements in telecommunications, finance, energy and the public sector.

Mapeley won the award by taking an approach involving the use of specialist outsourcing consultancy Quantum Plus. The reasons for the outsource project were determined and formulated into a strategy before implementation, which is very much aligned to the NOA's best practice guide for SME. Mapeley has achieved a 36% saving in cost amongst a number of other benefits.
